Description: Finavia (“Customer” or “Contracting Authority”) is a Finnish airport operator that enables smooth international flight connections through its national airport network. The objective of the procurement is to establish a framework agreement for Finavia's airport lighting equipment, encompassing approach lights, as well as runway and taxiway edge and centreline lights. The order includes lights intended for airport use from the following categories: Approach lighting Runway centreline and edge lighting, both elevated and inset. Taxiway centreline and edge lighting, both elevated and inset. For more detailed information, please refer to the Description of Supplies. Finavia operates 20 airports in Finland, and all of them are within the scope of the agreement.

Based on the Requests to Participate, Candidates meeting the minimum requirements shall be invited to participate as Tenderers and invited to Negotiate. Tenderers are invited to provide feedback, comments and suggestions regarding the documentation. Finavia may invite the Tenderers to several rounds of meetings, if necessary. Negotiation agenda shall be instructed in the Invitation to Negotiate. Participants have the opportunity

to ask questions at each stage. Tenderers are advised to consider that after the Procurement Decision has been made, agreements shall not be negotiated. Minor clarifications and additions to contact details and dates shall be made. Finavia sets suitability requirements to the Tenderers. Tenderer's own conditions and terms may not be included in any of the material it submits. Registration to Tarjouspalvelu supplier portal is free of charge. To avoid confusion, Candidates are advised to register to Tarjouspalvelu using the company name and ID of the entity that shall sign the Agreement.

2.1.4 General information

Additional information: As a result of this procurement procedure, framework agreement is established with all the tenderers that meet the minimum requirements. When value of the purchase exceeds the EU-threshold effective at the time of the Order, the supplier is selected by competitive tendering between framework agreement suppliers. Selection criterion used is defined in the call for tender considering each competitive tendering. Selection criterion may be price, quality, or best price-quality ratio. When value of the purchase is lower than the EU-threshold effective at the time of the Order, Customer may purchase Supplies from the framework agreement supplier it considers most suitable for such Order without order-specific competitive tendering between framework agreement suppliers. After the standard term of the Agreement set out below, the Contracting authority has the right in its own discretion to extend the term of this Agreement by three (3) years one (1) year at a time. The Contracting authority shall inform the Supplier on the use of each optional one (1) year period no later than three (3) months before the start of the optional agreement period in question.

2.1.6 Grounds for exclusion

Arrangement with creditors: The economic operator is in arrangement with creditors.

Participation in a criminal organisation: The economic operator itself or any person who is a member of its administrative, management or supervisory body or has powers of representation, decision or control therein has been the subject of a conviction by final judgment for participation in a criminal

organisation, by a conviction rendered at the most five years ago or in which an exclusion period set out directly in the conviction continues to be applicable.

Child labour and other forms of trafficking in human beings: The economic operator itself or any person who is a member of its administrative, management or supervisory body or has powers of representation, decision or control therein has been the subject of a conviction by final judgment for child labour and other forms of trafficking in human beings, by a conviction rendered at the most five years ago or in which an exclusion period set out directly in the conviction continues to be applicable.

Insolvency: The economic operator is the subject of insolvency or winding-up.

Breaching of obligations in the fields of labour law: The economic operator has, to its knowledge, breached its obligations in the field of labour law.

Guilty of misrepresentation, withheld information, unable to provide required documents and obtained confidential information of this procedure: The economic operator can confirm that: a) It has been guilty of serious misrepresentation in supplying the information required for the verification of the absence of grounds for exclusion or the fulfilment of the selection criteria, b) It has withheld such information, c) It has not been able, without delay, to submit the supporting documents required by a contracting authority or contracting entity, and d) It has undertaken to unduly influence the decision making process of the contracting authority or contracting entity, to obtain confidential information that may confer upon it undue advantages in the procurement procedure or to negligently provide misleading information that may have a material influence on decisions concerning exclusion, selection or award.

Purely national exclusion grounds: Any person who is a member of the economic operator's administrative, management or supervisory body or has powers of representation, decision or control therein has been the subject of a conviction by final judgment for work safety offence, working hours offence, work discrimination, extortionate work discrimination, violation of the right to organise or unauthorised use of foreign labour.

Conflict of interest due to its participation in the procurement procedure: The economic operator is aware of any conflict of interest, as indicated in national law, the relevant notice or the procurement documents due to its participation in the procurement procedure.
